Tryout Process

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to session for check-in
- Pick up assigned a T-shirt with a number
 - Shirt colors will be assigned based on your USAV age
- Have picture made with shirt
- Change into shirt and get ready for court time
- Participate in tryouts
 - o Families will be asked to leave at this point, as we
 - run a closed tryout
- At the end of session, change shirts and place tryou shirt in designated bin
- Repeat for Day 2

Evaluation Process

- Age level coaches will evaluate their designated age group athletes, along with the Director of Coaching and possibly other board members
- Coaches will be looking for:
 - Hustle Attitude Coachability Skill Volleyball I.Q Basic athletic ability - Positional needs
- Coach's desired team list will be reviewed by Director of Coaching for final approval
- If a position is offered,
 - Coach will call the athlete by 2pm on November 4
 - An offer by email will be sent by 5pm on November 4
 - Acceptance must occur via response to the above email by 5pm on November 5
 - Failure to accept by this deadline may result in your position being offered to another player

¹ Players who were born on or after July 1, 2004 and a high school student in the twelfth (12th) grade or below during some part of the current academic year are eligible to compete in 18 & under.

² Female Only - Players who were born on or after July 1, 2005, (who are defined as 18 & under by the USAV Age Definition) and are in the 11th grade for the current academic year are waivered to compete in 17 & under. (This age waiver is based on recruiting concerns for 11th grade girls previously required to participate in girls 18's qualifiers and the 18's GJNC.)

³ Male Only - Players who were born on or after July 1, 2009, OR players who were born on or after July 1, 2008 (15 years or younger) who shall neither have completed nor are in a grade higher than the eighth (8th) grade during the current academic year are eligible to play in the 14 & Under division. This exception is based on the net height difference of 7'4 1/8" to 7'11 5/8" between the 14 and Under Division to the 15 and Under Division.

4Male Only - Players who were born on or after July 1, 2009 (14 years or younger) who shall neither have completed nor are in a grade higher than the seventh grade (7th) during the current academic year are eligible for a Region approved waiver to compete in the boys 13's age group.

Male Only —Players who were born on or after July 1, 2010 (13 years or younger) who shall neither have completed nor are in a grade higher than the sixth grade (6th) during the current academic year are eligible for a Region approved waiver to compete in the boys 12's age group.
